### **STOLZ LEAVES BALTIMORE CITY TO CONTINUE EDUCATION**

Adam Stolz, the First Deputy Director of the Baltimore City Mayor's Office of Emergency Management, will be leaving his post with the City to return to college. Adam has been responsible for citywide all-hazards emergency planning and preparedness programs. Prior to serving in this position, he worked as a planner for Baltimore City Office of Emergency Management. Adam is a member of the Governor's Emergency Management Advisory Council. He has also served the Maryland Emergency Management Association as the Area III representative covering the counties of Carroll, Harford, Baltimore, Howard and Anne Arundel as well as Baltimore City and the City of Annapolis.
